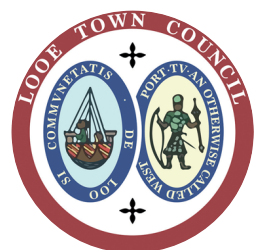
A guide to filming locations used in
the hit BBC show

Beyond Paradise

Produced by Looe Tourist Information, Looe Library &
Community Hub, Millpool, Looe. PL13 2AF

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Leaving the Tourist Information Centre at the Millpool, turn right up a short lane towards **Looe Bridge**. Cross the bridge to pause and admire the familiar view from the opening credits of 'Beyond Paradise'. Turn right into Buller Quay Car Park, where PC Hartford and the back-up team had the cyber-criminals under surveillance in S2 Ep6.



Walk along the quay past the **Fish Market**. Looe's RNLI Volunteer crew, landed here in S2 Ep3, when they investigated a may-day call from a local trawler, reporting a missing person. Also, in Ep4 the crew investigated a boat adrift at sea with a casualty on board (the missing priest).



As you walk along the quay, look to your left to see **Looe Guildhall**, or Shipton Abbott Police Station, across the square.



Continue along the quay and make your way to the seafront. **East Looe Beach** features throughout both series. Looe's famous **Banjo Pier** is to the right, Martha and Anne often sit on the benches here.

On arriving at the seafront, to your right you will see the **Lifeboat Station** and to your left, the shelter where Humphrey sat with his foster son enjoying their ice-creams. The beach was the setting in the final episode for both the ‘non-wedding’, and the Sixties Exercise Class which Humphrey was invited to attend.



Look across the estuary to West Looe.

Can you see **The Watermark Hotel**? This was used as the ‘Copacabana’ where Humphrey stayed the night before his ‘non-wedding’.

Retrace your steps along the quay or meander back through the pretty streets of the town and enjoy our shops, cafes and hostelries.

Pentillie Castle and Estate, Saltash.

www.pentillie.co.uk is used throughout both series as Humphrey & Martha's boat is moored here on the River Tamar next to Anne Lloyd's cottage.

Millbrook and the **Rame Peninsular** feature often in S2. The Old Fire Station in Millbrook was the location of the psychic's house in Ep2, while **Queen Adelaide's Grotto** at **Mount Edgcumbe** (www.mountedgcumbe.gov.uk) was used as a location in Ep4.



Mothecombe Beach on the South Devon coast also featured in Ep4.

The Murder Mystery event in S2 Ep1 took place on the South Devon Railway, and was filmed at **Buckfastleigh Station**, Devon.

Calstock Village, which is located on the **River Tamar**, has a large viaduct and can be seen in various episodes including the Art Gallery where Anne meets Richard's wife.



Port Eliot House & Gardens (www.porteliot.co.uk)

The Stables Café at Port Eliot features heavily throughout both series as Ten Mile Kitchen (Martha's Café) is located there.

Liskeard is a local market town easily reached by train from Looe (www.greatscenicrailways.co.uk/lines/looe-valley-line).

Liskeard Museum now has a special room containing props from S2 Ep6 when it featured as Shipton Abbot Museum.

Many of the exterior town shots of Shipton Abbott in S1 were filmed in **Launceston**, a picturesque town to the north of the county.
